

Member Data

For 2018 – 353 Households, 491 Members

• 160 new, 161 ended their membership

Since 2015

- 803 Memberships
- 450 ended their membership
 - 52% no longer needed,
 - 32% moved away,
 - 5% required services beyond our scope,
 - II% passed away



Volunteer Data

- 358 "active" in Volgistics at year-end down 11%
 - 225 became "active", 271 were "inactivated"
- 365 posted time up 7%
- 109 volunteers attended 19 Orientations and 109 attended 33 service skills classes


